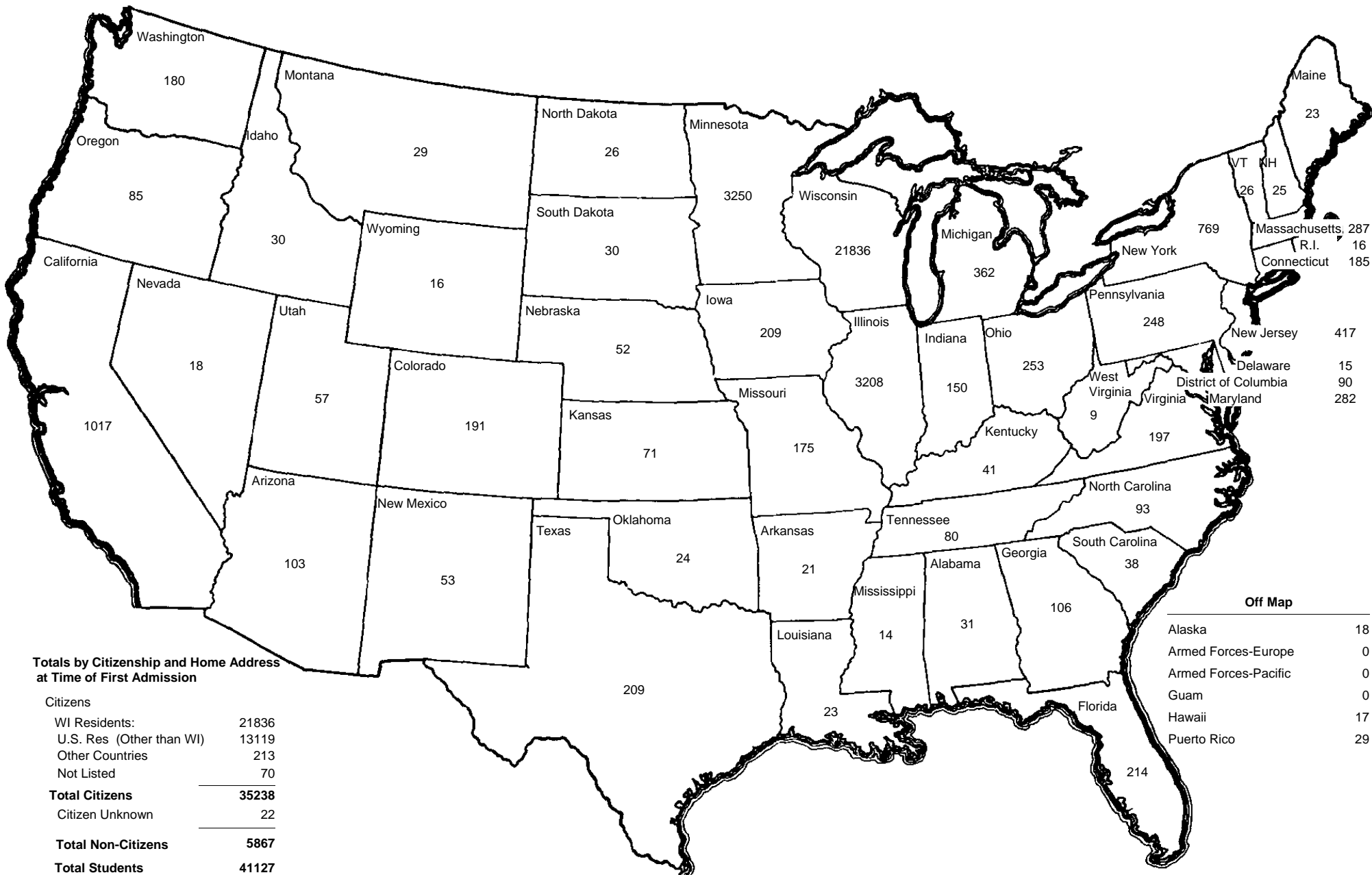
Home Address by Wisconsin County at Time of First Admission (U.S. Citizens)
